

**WALLA WALLA VALLEY QUILT GUILD
MYSTERY QUILT 2008**

FALL TOPPER

This is a very, very, very easy little autumn table topper. This month I'll give you the yardage requirements and some of the cuts. Next month I'll give you the final instructions and a picture of what it will look like.

Fabric requirements, fall colors:

Fabric A: Dark, $\frac{1}{4}$ (running) yard

Fabric B: Medium, $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Fabric C: Medium-light, $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Fabric D: Light, $\frac{3}{8}$ yard

Backing and binding: 1 yard

Scraps of medium and dark fabric for appliqués. (If you wish to do fusible appliqué, you will also need a small amount of fusible web.)

Cuts:

Fabric A:

2 pieces, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ "

2 pieces, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $30\frac{1}{2}$ "

2 pieces, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric B:

28 pieces, $1\frac{3}{4}$ " square

12 squares, $2\frac{1}{8}$ ", cut diagonally to form 24 triangles

4 pieces, cut per template (which you will get next month)

Fabric C:

12 squares, $2\frac{1}{8}$ ", cut diagonally to form 24 triangles

2 rectangles, $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{4}$ " cut diagonally, bottom left to top right

2 rectangles, $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{4}$ " cut diagonally, top left to bottom right

4 pieces, $2\frac{7}{8}$ " square

8 pieces, $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{7}{8}$ "

Fabric D:

1 rectangle, $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ "
