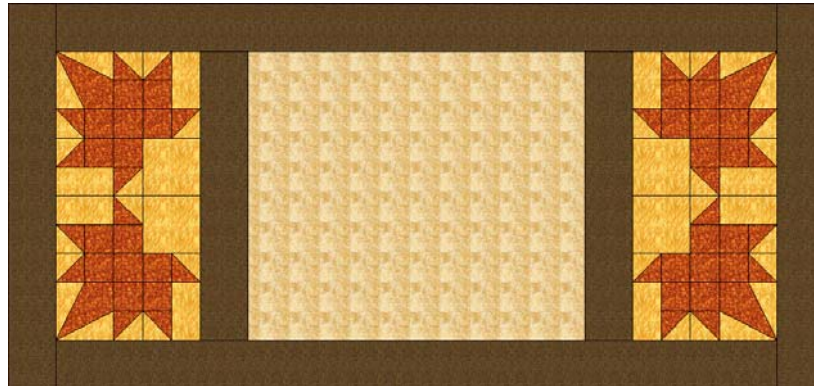


WALLA WALLA VALLEY QUILT GUILD
MYSTERY QUILT 2008

FALL TOPPER



1. Sew the $2\frac{1}{2}$ x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the short sides of the $12\frac{1}{2}$ x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Set aside.
2. Using the template, cut four pieces from the medium fabric. Sew them to the triangles cut from the $1\frac{7}{8}$ x $3\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles. (Figure 1)
3. Using the triangles cut from the $2\frac{1}{8}$ " squares, sew 16 half-square triangles.
4. Sew the pieces together per the illustration to make four blocks. (Figure 2)
5. Sew the blocks together per the illustration. (Figures 3 & 4)
6. Sew the blocks to either end of the first piece.
7. Sew the $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x $30\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to either side of the above piece.
8. Sew the $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to either end.
9. Quilt and bind as desired. With any luck, it will look something like the picture at the top of the page.

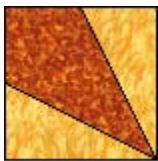

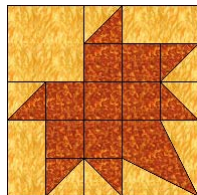

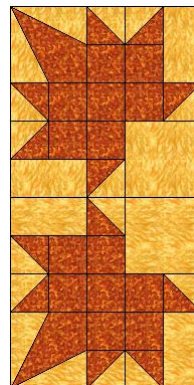

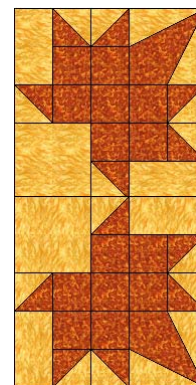
